Residential Programme at Grafham Water Centre

The purpose of the programme is to provide and present an opportunity for young people (18 to 26 year olds):

- To experience, discover, identify, discuss and consider the patterns of leadership current in society
- To observe and recognise the qualities of leadership in other people and in themselves through the media of activities, personal contact and experiences which will be challenging physically, intellectually and socially
- To gain skills, awareness, understanding and self-confidence which will enable participants to return to their own community and contribute in a leadership capacity
- Make life-changing choices

The programme will include:

- Interaction and group dynamics
- Simulation business exercises which will include a computer-based simulation and role play
- Physical activities offering new experiences and the learning of skills both in didactic and collaborative sessions and with opportunities for experiential selfmanaged learning
- Expedition presenting challenge, adventure and opportunity for initiative
- Talks and discussions on the pattern of leadership
- Workshops on personal development skills, including opportunities to act as leaders
- Preparation and delivery of a formal presentation
- Opportunities for contact between individuals of differing background and experience
- Group tutorials to identify needs and to provide support
- Social occasions involving hospitality and protocol
